Jury process: Established artists need not be juried. We reserve the right to see photos or slides of any artist to ensure a high-quality fair.

Media: All media will be considered: painting, sculpture, photography, stained glass, crafts etc. All work must be original: no "kits" or work from commercial molds accepted.

Acceptance: Notifications of acceptance will be mailed as soon as possible after we receive your entry form.

Deadline for Entries: June 20, 2011

Turtle Lake Resort is a family-oriented "clothing optional" nudist resort. Artists should know they will encounter guests or patrons who are "clothes-free". See the other side of this form for more details.

Amenities: Free coffee and donuts or bagels for the artists during set-up time. Special rates for overnight guests (see other side).

General Information: *No entry fee! No commission is taken on sales.* Artists are responsible to have their Michigan Sales Tax license.

Booth Dimensions: Spaces will be laid out for booths that are 12' x 12' in size. Limited electrical power is available if needed. Artists must supply their own display equipment. Protection in case of rain is the responsibility of the artist.
